Kentucky Derby Weekend

This weekend is always one of the premier times in horse racing as the 139th running of the \$2,000,000 Kentucky Derby will take place at Churchill Downs this Saturday. The Derby goes as the 11th race and is the final leg of a Pick 4 that has quite a bit of local interest. The first leg of the Pick 4 has last years' Ballerina winner **Class Included** in the line-up, she is 30-1 on the morning line in the \$250,000 Grade II Churchill Distaff Mile on the turf, post-time is 11:59 a.m. The next race features **Handsome Mike** (12-1) and Mario Gutierrez in the seven furlong \$400,000 Churchill Downs Handicap, post-time is 12:49 p.m. The third leg includes the 2012 Horse of the Year **Wise Dan** in the \$500,000 Grade I Woodford Reserve Classic, which is scheduled to go off at 1:44 p.m. Then the big one of the afternoon, the Kentucky Derby, which is scheduled to run at approximately 3:20 p.m. our time, with a field of 19 three year olds doing battle over a mile and one quarter. Kelowna's Charles Fipke has two starters in the race, **Java's War** at 15-1 and **Golden Soul** at 50-1. Good luck Chuck!!
