Hastings Racing Club in Action

Racing resumes this weekend with a seven race program on Saturday that gets underway at 1:50 p.m.

The race of the day is race four, a \$50,000 optional claimer that will feature the Hastings Racing Club's newest acquisition, Square Dancer. His task will be a tough one with 2013 BC Derby winner Title Contender, stakes winner Devil in Disguise and stakes placed runners Twistgrips, Distillery and Mysterious Soul in the lineup.

The newly formed Hastings Racing club has 250 partners that invested \$200 each to be part of the syndicate. The HRC currently owns the two year old Urban Achiever as well as Square Dancer, who was a private purchase from Seattle based trainer Mike Chambers. Urban Achiever was purchased in May at the Barretts two-year-old in training sale for \$25,000.
